



## Steps Under The Stars Terms & Conditions – 2009

**Thank you so much for your interest in our Steps Under The Stars event. Please read the terms and conditions below before registering. For further, more detailed information please read the FAQs**

Steps Under The Stars is a walk between Guildford and Farnham for female entrants.

Participants must be 16 years old or over on the 12<sup>th</sup> September 2009.

All participants aged 16 – 17 years old must be accompanied by an adult participant, who has signed a Guardian's Declaration taking responsibility for them.

Think carefully about which distance route you feel able to complete. Please be aware that both routes contain uneven ground including sand underfoot and hills. You cannot swap routes on the night.

Steps Under The Stars is not a race – do not run or jog, just walk. No walker must pass the nominated lead walker.

Registration Fee is £15 and is non refundable.  
Registration Closing Date is: Monday 31<sup>st</sup> August 2009

Once registered you will be assigned a Walker Number, which will be detailed in your walkers pack. On the night, you will need to sign in and will then be given your walker number to wear on the walk. Once you receive this, you must complete the medical form on the back of the number to validate your entry in the event. Please do not swap numbers with other participants and your place cannot be transferred at any time to anyone else.

All participants must sign the declaration on the registration form in order to take part. For online registration, your payment automatically confirms you have read these terms and conditions and accept them in their entirety.

Please bring and wear suitable clothing and footwear for appropriate weather conditions and follow directions of both the marshals and signs at all times. You will be given a bottle of water at the start of the walk, any additional refreshment you should bring with you, or there will be extra drinks that can be purchased.

Participants agree to bring and use their own torch with fully charged batteries.

Phyllis Tuckwell Hospice (the charity and limited company) reserves the right to refuse entry to any person who is unfit to complete the walk on the night.

The route is unsuitable for wheelchairs

No dogs allowed.

You understand that photographs of walkers may be taken at the event for post-publicity purposes and to advertise future events and you consent to their use.

All participants should be in reasonable health and fitness and responsible for your own medical condition. Please consult your doctor prior to taking part if you are unsure if you will be fit enough.

Participants must take responsibility for their own safety when crossing roads.

No alcohol must be consumed either before or during the walk.

Participants agree that you enter this event at your own risk and you will not hold Phyllis Tuckwell Hospice (the charity and limited company), their employees and volunteers responsible for any personal injury, accident, loss, damage or public liability
